Food for thought from J

"You can't see the forest for the trees" is probably an expression that has been applied appropriately to each of us at one time or another. This saying suggests we are so focused on the details, perhaps the trials, challenges, even the blessings right in front of us, that we are unable to consider the possible existence of a transcendent, bigger picture or purpose. Interestingly, as we consider those first followers of Christ immediately after the resurrection, this seems to be a common condition for them as well.

In Matthew, those first visitors to the tomb were so shocked it was empty and by the appearance of those heavenly beings that greeted them, that they were unable to consider the miraculous possibility that Christ had truly risen and the implications of that fact. Similarly, in Luke's gospel, those travelers on the road to Emmaus were so consumed with their disappointment that the hoped for redemption of Israel seemed lost, with the death of Jesus, that they failed to recognize Jesus in their midst, even as he revealed to them the secrets of God's plan of redemption as spelled out in the scripture. Perhaps most famously, John's gospel tells us Thomas demanded to observe the wounds on the body of Jesus before he would consider the bigger picture possibility of the resurrection of Christ. In each of these cases, it was the fear, the doubt, the frustration, and the disappointment of the moment that caused these disciples to forget that, in the grand narrative of redemption, Jesus himself had foretold not just his death, but also, his resurrection.

How often do we allow our momentary problems, doubts, and even our times of joy to keep us from remembering that we serve a risen savior who is in the world today? When we first receive that bad news or dreaded medical diagnosis, do we turn immediately to God seeking God's strength and comfort and purpose to help us face the uncertainties ahead? Conversely, how often do we stop while playing with our children or grandchildren or after we receive that clean bill of health or financial windfall and say, "thank you, Lord. I give you all the praise and glory?"

Yes, we live in a world of trees that threaten to block our view of God's wonderful forest of blessings. Thank God, as we focus our attention on the resurrection during this specific season, it calls us to rise above the mundane and ordinary details of our daily life and consider the immensity of this singular event in our history and what it means for us individually and as a whole. May the resurrection provide us all with a regular reminder of the majesty of Jesus and the big picture of the gospel so that we never again miss the forest for the trees.
