Food for thought from J

I am often questioned about the difference between church denominations, particularly Methodist versus Baptist or another type of protestant church. And, while there are differences between Methodist (Wesleyan) theology, and that of other denominations, the name – Methodist – is less about theology, and more about the practice of our faith. In fact, the term "methodist" was, originally, a derogatory name given to John Wesley and his colleagues who were particularly rigorous in their practice of spiritual disciplines or "methods" in pursuit of growing as disciples of Christ. These methods included regular worship, receiving the Sacraments, Bible study, regimented prayer time, and helping the needy. One of the keys to all this method, though, was the importance of doing it **often** and **communally**. While we, as modern Methodists, continue to enjoy many of these activities, together, every Sunday, we often lose sight of the importance of making additional regular and communal *Bible study* a part of our personal "method." Yet, this should seem particularly important to us if we consider how unlikely it is that we could ever hope to learn all we need to know about something as central to our growth as Christians as *The Bible*, simply by reading it by ourselves or sitting through a 20-minute sermon once a week.

Fortunately, this is why, at Mossy Creek, we have a solid and growing offering of group Bible studies and Sunday school classes that provide regular opportunities to study scripture and the tenets of our faith - together:

Sunday School

- The Young at Heart class is reforming right now with a focus on traditional Cokesbury Sunday school curriculum.
- The Choir Room Class is studying C.S. Lewis's *Mere Christianity*, which many experts view as one of the most important theological writings of the 20th century.
- The Fellowship class focuses on devotional practices and group prayer. They meet in the old Middle School classroom in the main church building.
- On April 30th, we will begin weekly confirmation classes for our young members who are seeking to be confirmed and to make a public affirmation of their faith in Christ.

Other Bible Study Opportunities

- The Tuesday Bible study meets weekly at noon to take a systematic look at one specific book of *The Bible*. We are now studying Paul's letter to the Galatians, which is an excellent introduction to the writings of the great apostle.
- Our UMW meets monthly for fellowship and to study biblical topics. They are wrapping up their current study of the book, *The Mothers and Daughters of the Bible Speak*.

If you aren't involved in at least one of these activities, I encourage you to consider making time to join one. If you need to find a more convenient time for Bible study, or you have a desire to lead a specific study of your own, please give me a call and we will work toward finding a way to add that to our current list of offerings. Whatever the case, *The Bible* remains one of the God's greatest gifts to help us understand God, God's plan, and our place in it. May we all make studying God's word a priority and a method for strengthening our faith and drawing closer to God as disciples of Christ.
